The Emporia Friends of the Library annual meeting was called to order by President **Dee Schwinn** on February 1, 2022, at 5:00 pm.

Treasurer Michael Lang reported year-end 2021

balances as follows:

Lyon County State Bank: \$11,649.43

Emporia Community Foundation: \$30,947.06

The sum of \$12,000 was spent to directly benefit the Emporia Public Library by purchasing a Charlie Cart. Additional funds are earmarked to pay for a new digital electronic sign for the library.
